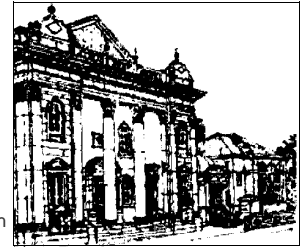

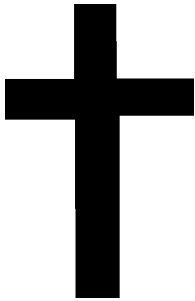

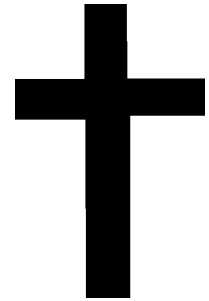

### Message from Rita Slater

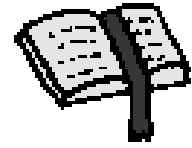
